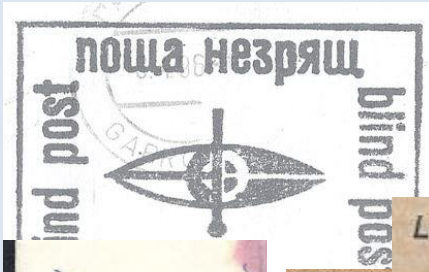

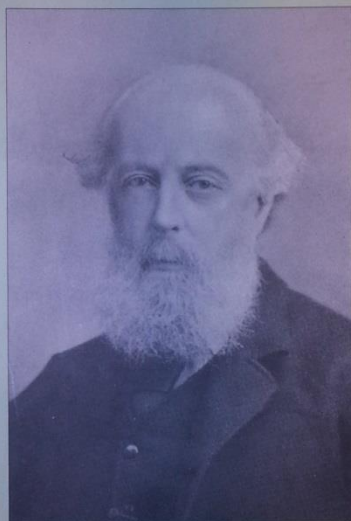

### Sweden

UPU Circular of 12 November 1906 stated that in Sweden mail for the blind sent under band: within the local rayon: at 2 öre per 50g or part in the general rayon: 4 öre per 50g or part

### Switzerland

In July 1906 the GPO in London were informed as follows:

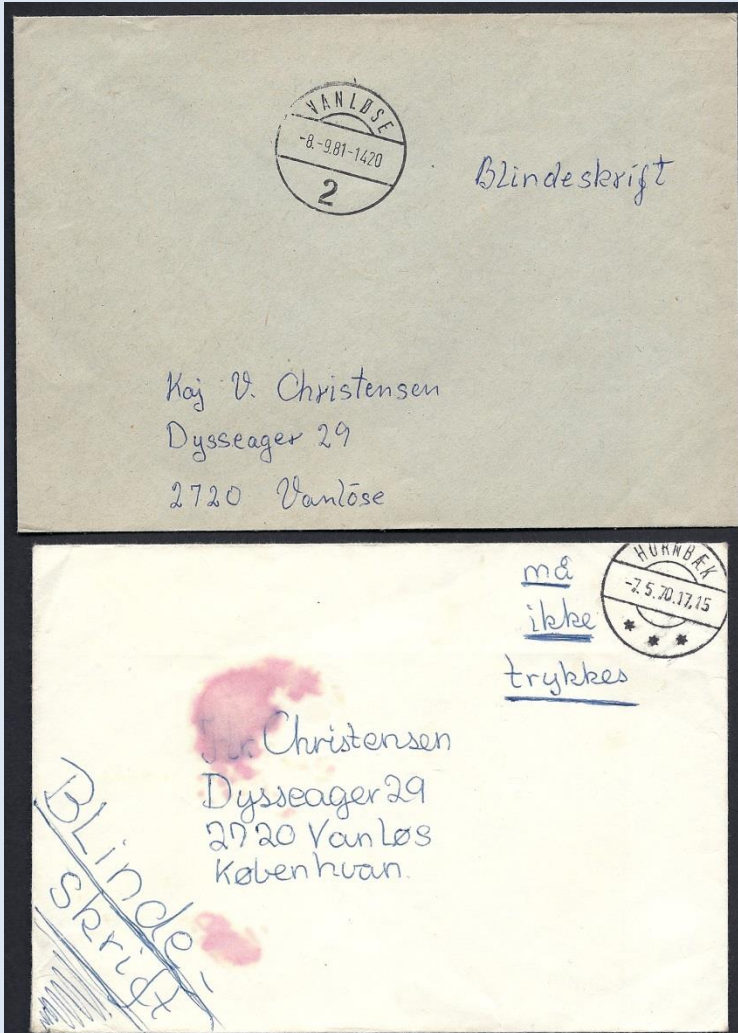
By 1906 no special mention of papers for the blind could be found in the Swiss Postal Regulations.

The rates for printed papers including embossed printing or writing were :-

Up to 50 g	2 centimes
50 - 250 g	5 centimes
250 - 500 g	10 centimes

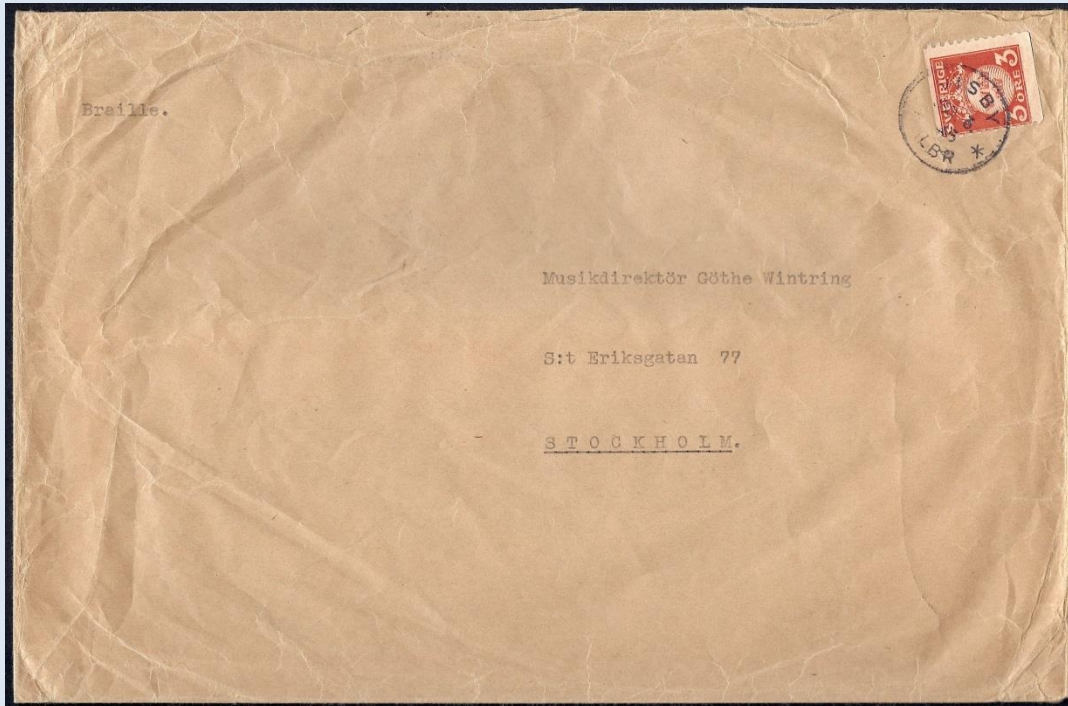

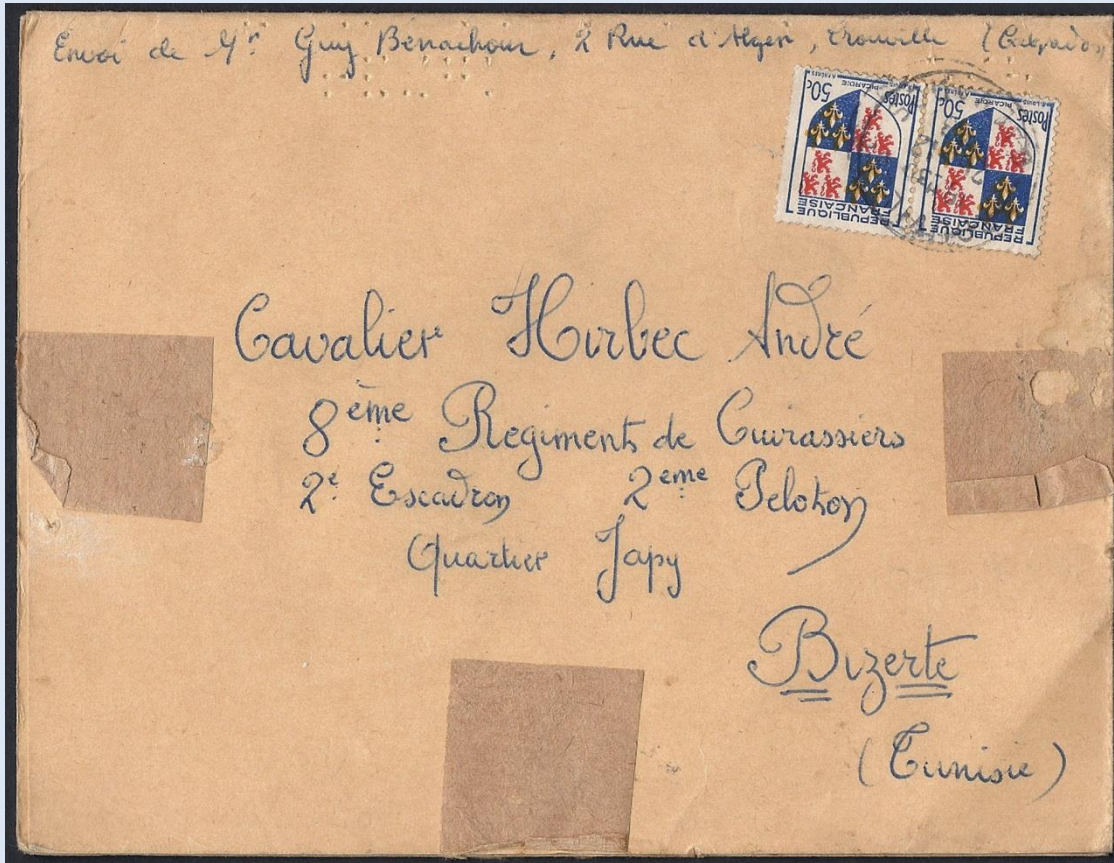

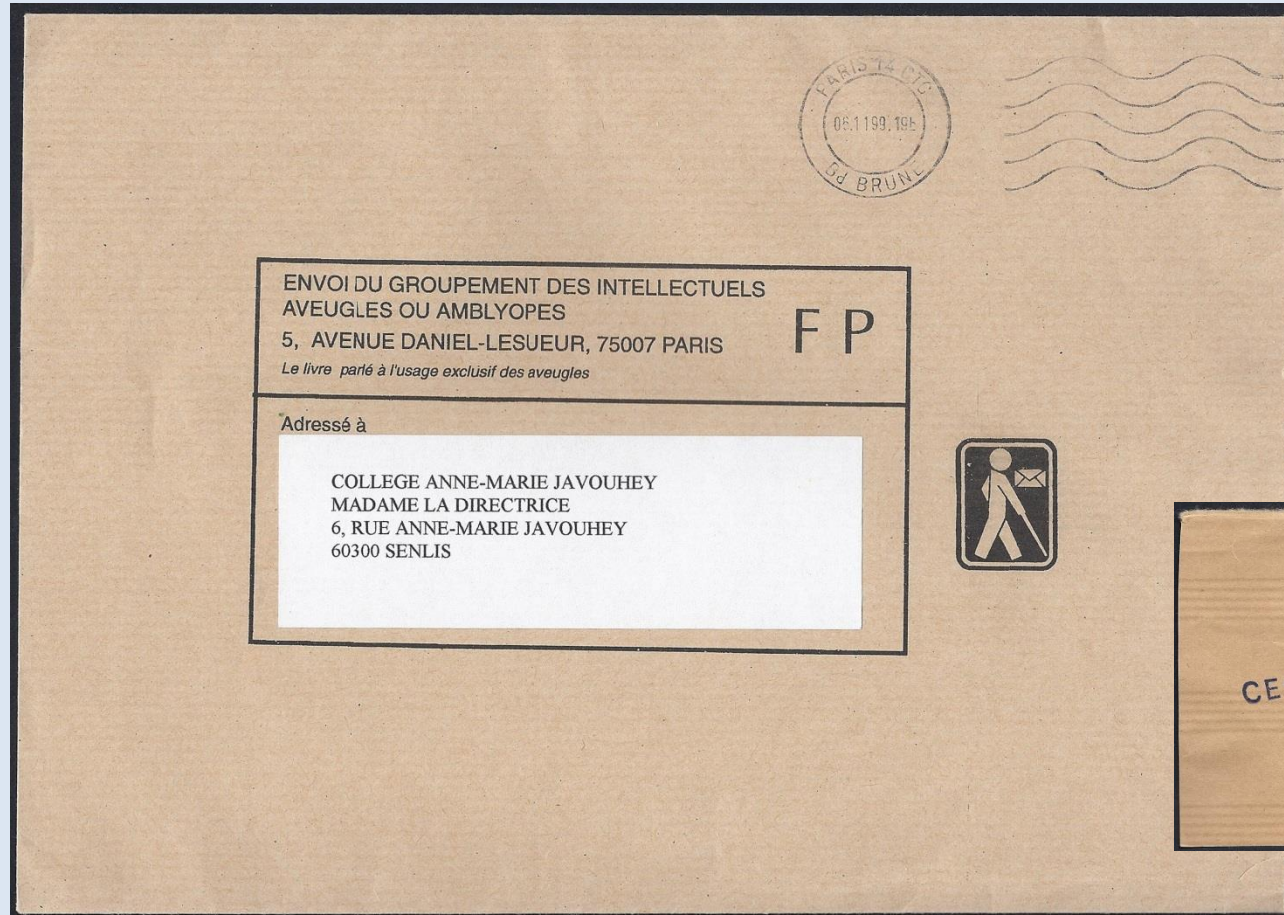

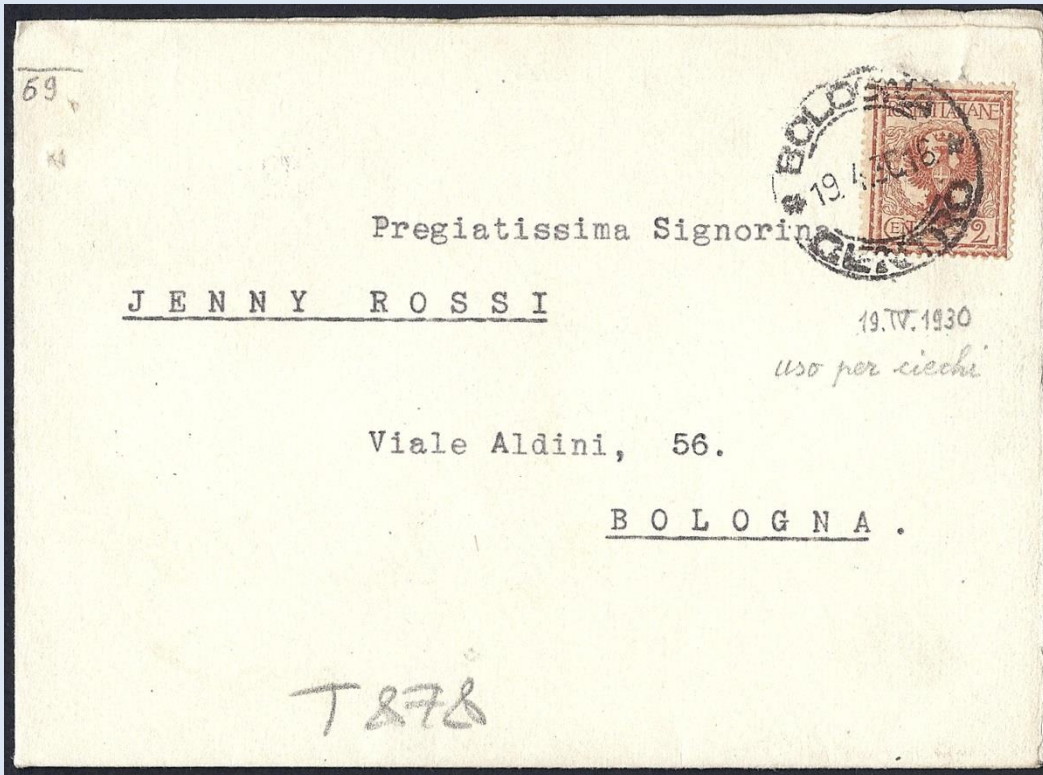

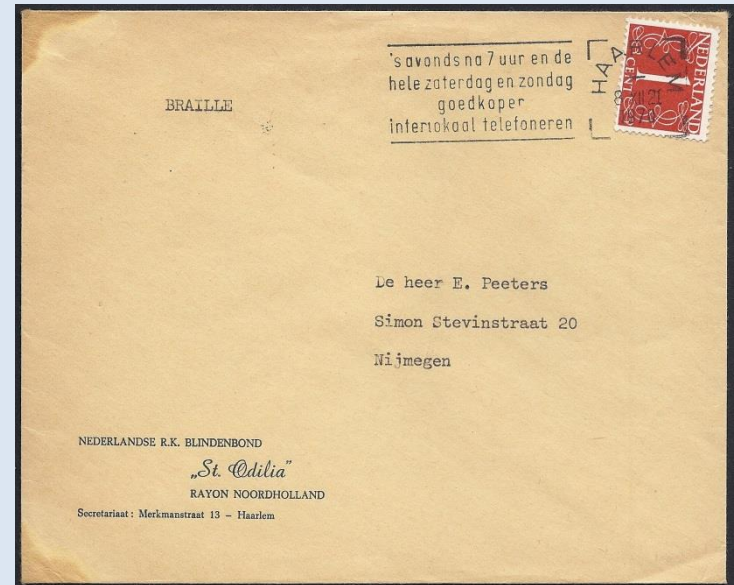

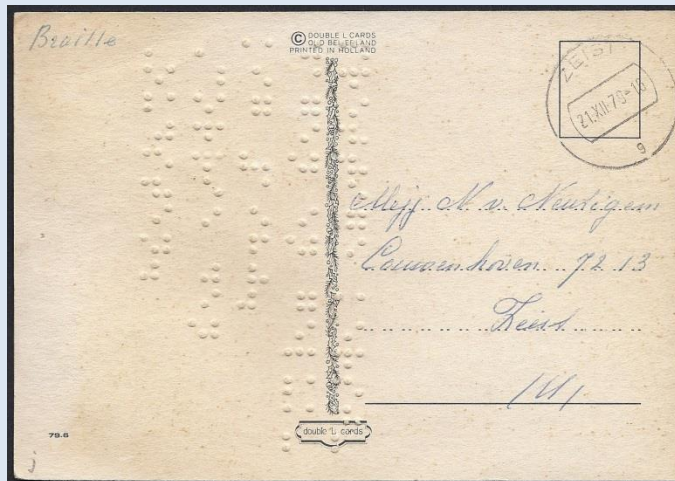

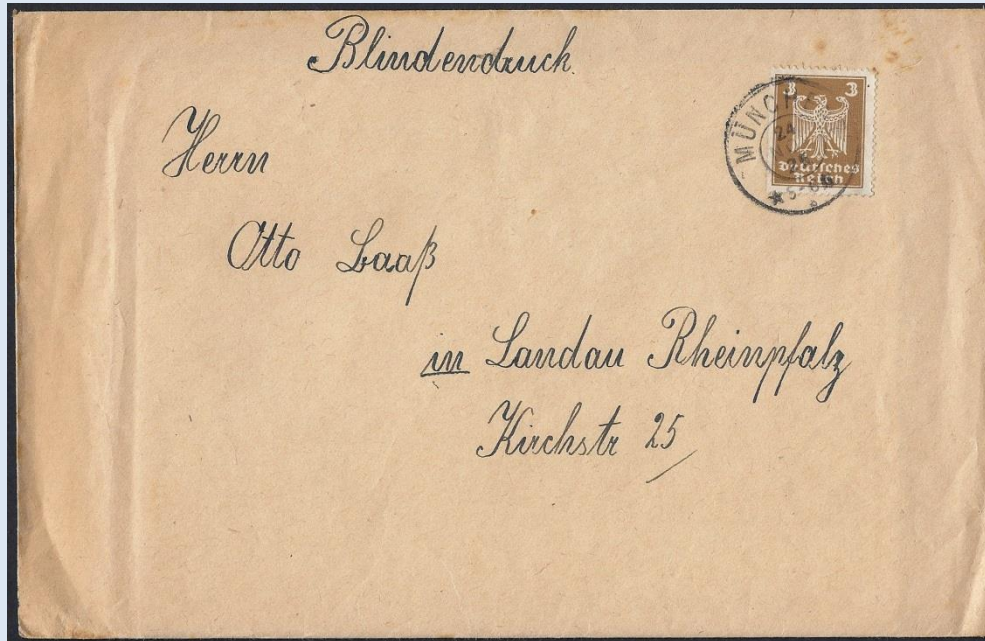


Innenlands 0 – 1 kg: 1 cent

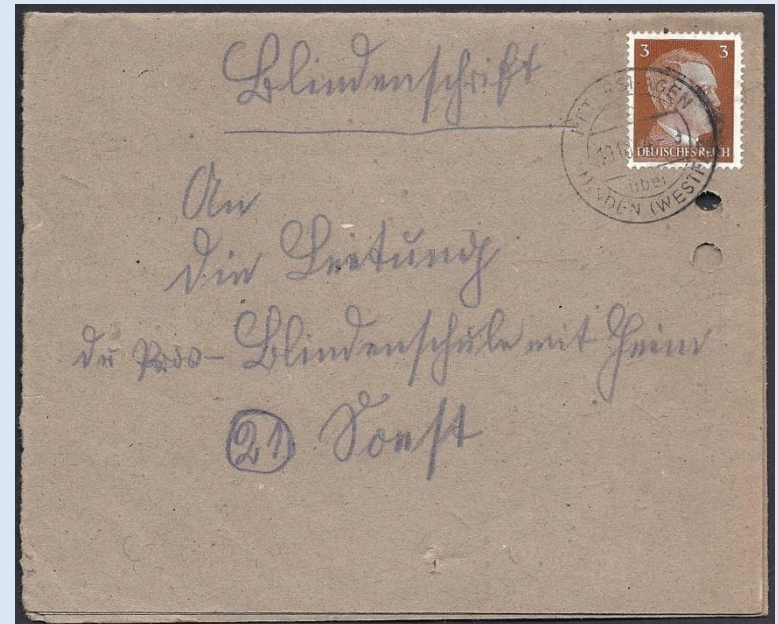

Innenlands 0 – 500 gram: 3 pf



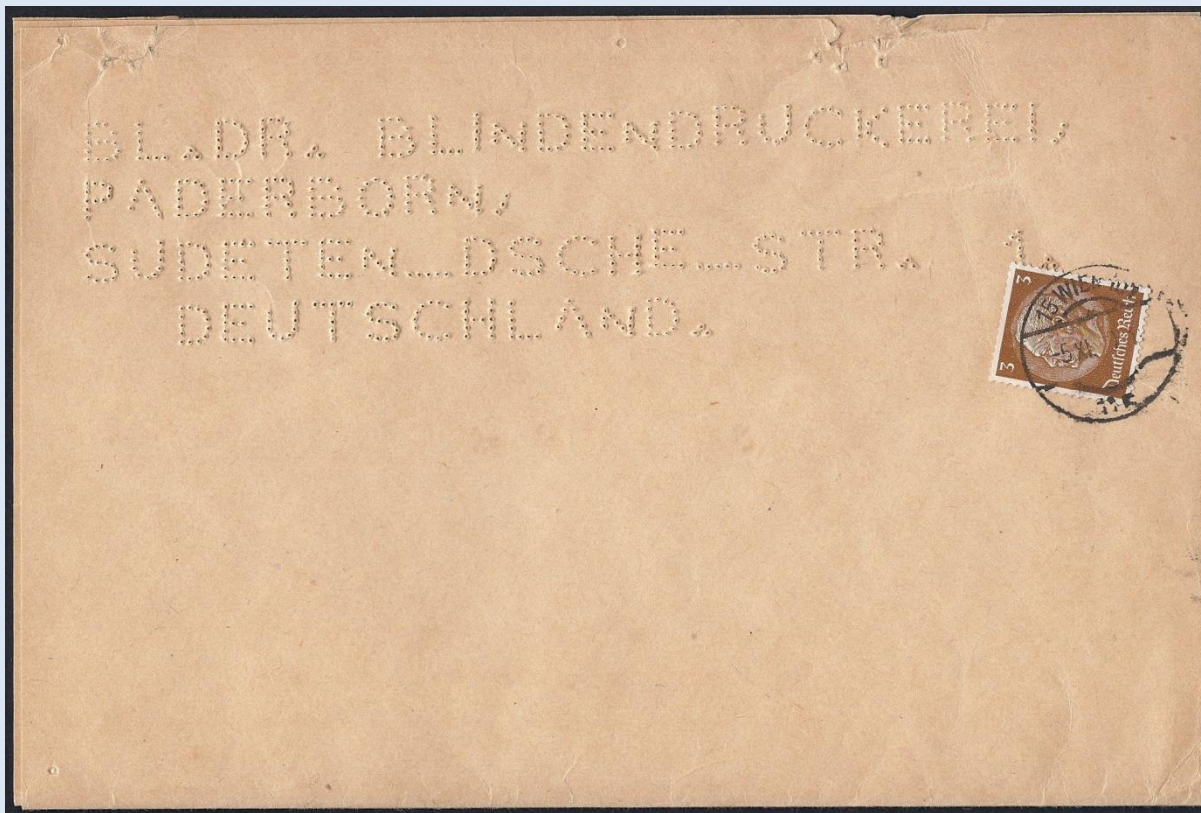

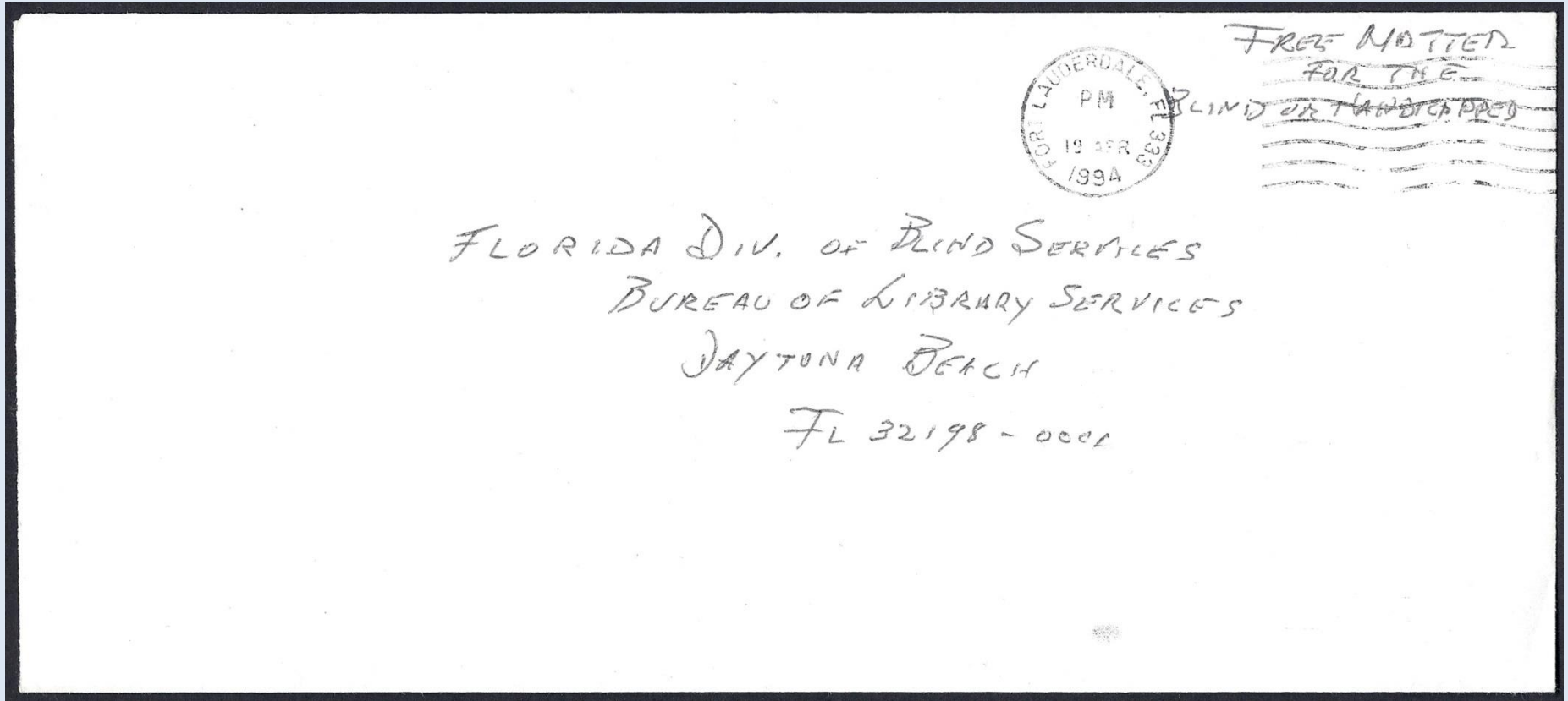


«Innenlands, Tyskland-Østerrike» 0 – 1 kg: 3 pf

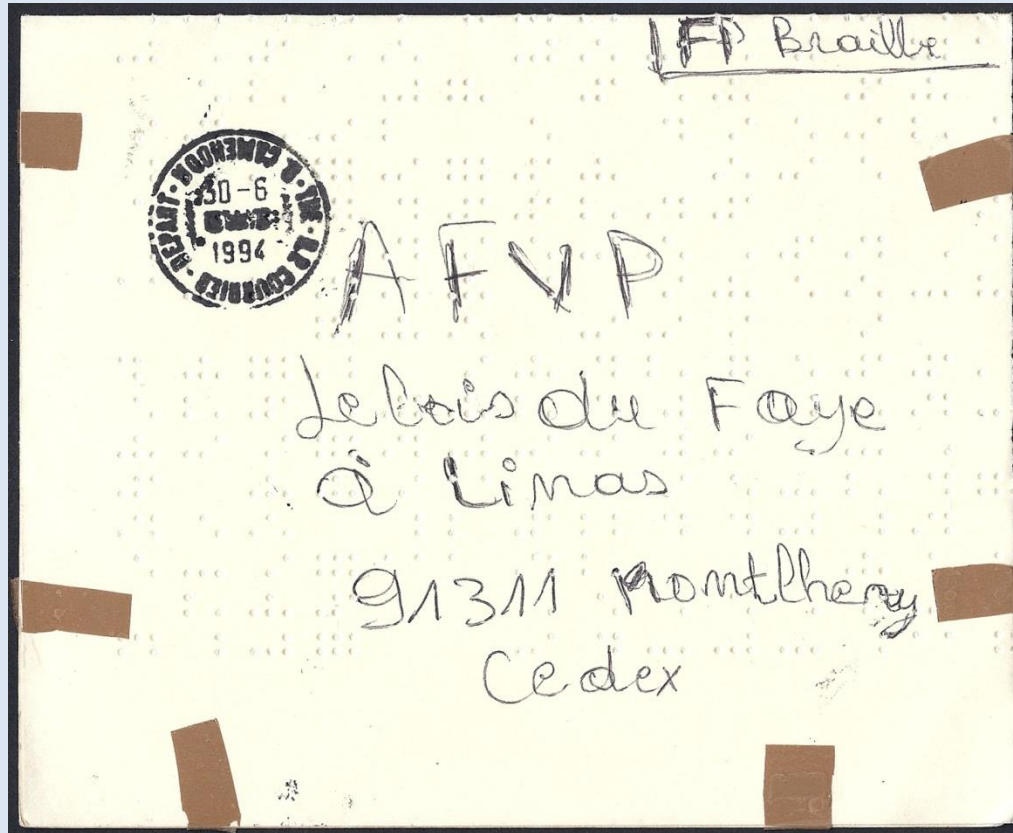
